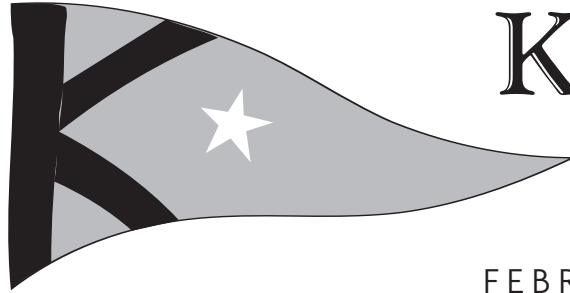

# From the Race Committee

## 2007 Racing Organizational Meeting – Tuesday, March 6th at 1900 KPYC Clubhouse

Please come if you plan to race, would like to crew, want to volunteer for Race Committee or are merely curious about racing.

For those who are curious: Newcomers are especially welcome! Racing either as crew or skipper is a good way to learn to handle a boat better, and provides a good social opportunity, both on and off your boat. We can structure one or more races to be pursuit format so that novices need not be as intimidated by the fun of a crowded starting line. Even if your boat is not a “racer,” it can be fun to come out and try your skills against the fleet. As the owner of *Lioness* one of the oldest, biggest and slowest traditional cruising boats out there, I can attest it’s not necessary to have a modern ‘rule beater’ to have fun – though in light winds, one does grit ones teeth a bit.

We need to confirm races, starting and scoring formats, schedule to blend with PSA, MASS BAY, and GMORA events, as well as discuss any new events such as a distance races and possible coordination with the Sailing School.

Volunteers for running races on *Chumly* or your suitable boat are particularly welcome, experienced preferred, we will train. Chase boats for the single-handed race are sought as well.

### Traditional races:

**John Paul Jones** in June: 2–4 hour Saturday race around government buoys.

**Whaleback** in July: 2–4 hour Saturday race around government buoys.

**Lobster** race in September: One or more shorter races on Sat. Can be a Regatta of several races etc.

**Single-handed** in September: A single windward leeward race.

### Potential new races:

**Novice** race: Open to all skippers who have not won any PHRF or class race in Portsmouth.

**Youth** race: Must be skippered and crewed by under 18 (as well as owner aboard to coach).

**Distance** race: Portsmouth to Portland (Monhegan Feeder). Can be overnight or Friday AM.

**Distance** race: Portsmouth to Marblehead (PHRF-NE Feeder). Can be overnight or Thursday AM.

**Distance** race: Portsmouth to Portsmouth “Mini -50” to Cape Anne and back.
