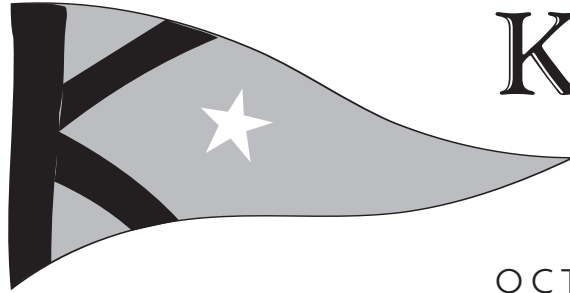

Youth Sailing Program

WE HAVE HAD A SEMINAL YEAR IN THE KITTELY POINT Yacht Club Youth Sailing Program. Not only did Chris Pastore do an extraordinary job running the program but he has also submitted a list of recommendations to improve the program next year. The sailing program has become so successful that it is now at a point where we need club members to step up and help administer the program in conjunction with our competent staff.

One of the main goals for this coming season is to establish a Sailing Program Board or Sub Committee. Doug Keith, Rob Pruyn, Wendy and I have begun this process, and Sean Conner has volunteered to join the board. We have arranged with Chris Pastore to continue to help us develop the materials necessary for a committee of members to oversee the program while we continue to have a paid staff to run the program for the club.
