



NOTICE OF RACE
JOHN PAUL JONES REGATTA - June 19, 2004
Organizing Authority - Kittery Point Yacht Club New Castle New Hampshire 03854

- 1.0 Rules.** The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2001-2004 (RRS), the prescriptions of US SAILING, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, and the rules of the J-24 Class Association (except as altered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions).
- 2.0 Eligibility.** Boats of the following classes are eligible to enter:
- J-24
 - J-105
 - PHRF Racing, 2004 PHRF-NE certificate required.
 - PHRF Cruising, non-spinnaker, 2004 PHRF-NE certificate preferred. A boat without a valid certificate will be assigned a provisional handicap using the base PHRF-NE rating +6 seconds a mile.
- 2.1 Safety.** All boats are required to meet minimum government regulation for safety equipment and comply with the Offshore Racing Council rules for category IV. The race committee reserves the right to inspect any boat for required equipment and may disqualify boats found not in compliance.
- 3.0 Entry.** Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it the required fees and a copy of the rating certificate to:

- 4.0 Fee.**
The fee for the regatta is \$30 per boat, which includes admission to the social function at the KPYC for three individuals. Tickets for additional crew can be purchased for \$10 each.
- 5.0 Race Schedule.**
- Warning for first class scheduled at 11:55 AM.
 - Two races planned for PHRF Race and J105 fleets.
 - One race planned for PHRF cruising fleet.
 - Three races or more planned for J-24 fleet.
- Final class and divisions will be set once number of participants is known. The race committee reserves the right to assign class breaks or to condense classes. A single race will be sufficient to constitute the regatta.
- 6.0 Scoring.**
Results of the regatta will be based on the low point scoring system with no throw out races. The PHRF yachts results will be handicapped using the time on time system.
- 7.0 Social Schedule.**
Friday June 18, 2004
- 18:00 Skippers meeting KPYC, Final sailing instructions and scratch sheets will be available.
- Saturday June 19th, 2004
- 17:00 Social event starts on KPYC deck. Pot luck dinner, grill open for use, beer and mixers available.
 - 17:30 Presentation to new KPYC members
 - 17:45 Race trophy presentation
 - 18:00 Band starts, Dancing and merry making begin in earnest.
- 7.0 Trophies:**
Trophies will be awarded for yachts finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class. Additional awards will be presented for Best Performance for a yacht that normally does not race and for Best Dressed Crew. These special awards are at the complete discretion of the race committee and might not be awarded if no yacht meets the expectation of the committee.
- 8.0 Changes to this Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions.** Any change to this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions will be made by email to the Skippers of each registered yacht by Friday prior, at the skippers meeting or through hails made on VHF Channel 68 prior to the first Warning Sound the day of the race. The Notice of race and Sailing Instructions will be posted and available at the Kittery Point Yacht Club, New Castle NH.
