- 1.0 Rules.** The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2001-2004 (RRS), the prescriptions of US SAILING, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.0 Eligibility.** Any mono-hull yacht that has a valid 2004 PHRF-NE rating or for which the race committee can determine a provisional handicap using the base PHRF-NE ratings and appropriate adjustments. Skippers without valid 2004 PHRF-NE ratings are encouraged to fill out a rating form and submit it to the race committee as soon as possible. A rating form is available on the PHRF-NE web site.

- 2.1 Safety.** All boats are required to meet minimum government regulation for safety equipment and comply with the Offshore Racing Council rules for category IV. The race committee reserves the right to inspect any boat for required equipment and may disqualify boats found not in compliance.

There is no entry fee for this race.
- 5.0 Race Format and Schedule.**
 - A single division, PHRF racing will be utilized for this race.
 - Use of spinnakers, autopilots and power winches is allowed.
 - Skippers Meeting KPYC 9:00 AM.
 - Only the Skipper can be aboard during the race.
 - Warning for is scheduled at 12:00 AM.
 - A single race is planned for the division.
 - 17:00 time limit for the race.The race committee reserves the right to assign class breaks.
- 6.0 Scoring.**
The PHRF yachts results will be handicapped using the time on time system.

9:00 Skippers meeting at the KPYC.
17:30 Reception for the skippers post race at the KPYC.
- 7.0 Trophies:**
Trophies will be awarded for yachts finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd; a prize will be awarded to all yachts that finish the race. The first yacht to finish helmed by a KPYC member will have the skippers name engraved in the perpetual trophy on display at the KPYC.
